

“Early Development in the Sumerian Pantheon”

The paper discusses some problems about the early phases of the development of the Early Dynastic Sumerian pantheon based on the analysis of mythological texts, royal inscriptions, god-lists, etc.

Several hypothetical possibilities and theories are discussed:

- 1) Is it possible to claim that Enki (or the mother goddess) were originally the supreme power(s) in the pantheon instead of the later political god Enlil?
- 2) Which were the main reasons behind the development towards the so-called canonical pantheon of Sumer (finalizing ca during Ur III)?
