William V. Davis is an award-winning poet and critic. He has published more than 100 essays in scholarly periodicals as well as half a dozen books of literary criticism—most recently *R. S. Thomas: Poetry and Theology* (2007). As William Virgil Davis he has published four books of poetry and hundreds of poems in a wide variety of periodicals. His most recent book of poetry is *Landscape and Journey*, which won the New Criterion Poetry Prize and the Helen C. Smith Memorial Award for Poetry. His other books of poetry are: *One Way to Reconstruct the Scene*, which won the Yale Series of Younger Poets Prize; *The Dark Hours*, which won the Calliope Press Chapbook Prize; and *Winter Light*. He has taught at several universities in the USA and as a visiting professor at the Universities of Vienna, Copenhagen, and Wales (Swansea). He is the recipient of numerous awards and honors, including three Senior Fulbright Fellowships, the James Sims Prize for American Literature, and various grants and fellowships in Creative Writing. He has given readings of his own poetry and lectured on nineteenth and twentieth-century British and American literature literally around the world. Currently, he is Professor of English and Writer-in-Residence at Baylor University.
