### **Crusader Glass in the Latin Kingdom of Jerusalem**

Glass vessels and objects were part of daily life in the Near East for decades, used as table-ware, storage vessels, lighting devices, cosmetic and medicinal vessels and as window-panes. During the days of the Latin Kingdom of Jerusalem, many archaeological sites in Israel, have revealed the continuation of use and production of glass finds by the Crusaders.

The glass finds from the Crusader castles and towns at Monfort, 'Akko, 'Atlit and Arsuf will be analysed to examine social aspects and commercial connections during the days of the Crusaders in the Holy Land, between different inhabitants, knights and civilians, Muslims and Christians.
