AstroMundus Grading System



The grading system adopted by the AstroMundus Consortium is the one in place at the coordinating institution, the University of Innsbruck (Austria). Exams given at the partner universities will be graded according to the local grading systems and then converted to the Austrian system according to the conversion tables provided below. In the Diploma Supplement, for each exam the original grade will be reported in addition to the grade in the Austrian system. Whenever a partner university needs to calculate the average grade obtained by a student during the entire Masters Course, the reverse conversion table reported below is used.
