Zero Tolerance, a National Film Board of Canada production, presents – in an utterly moving manner – everyday life in Montréal, which, for some people, resembles a dictatorship by the police force and which, not at all, fits into the picture of a seemingly well-functioning, multicultural Canadian city.

This hard-hitting film not only reveals the racism within Montréal's police force, but especially thematizes the highly controversial policy of zero tolerance which young people of colour have to face day by day. By means of a blend of cinema vérité and personal testimonies, Michka Saäl (director) shows a side of Montréal and its people that will not leave you untouched.
