Fees

- 1- Exchange students pay the tuition fees at their home university and \$2200 CAN to ÉÉF to cover the costs of lodging, meals and activities.
- 2- International students of our non-credited program pay \$2700 CAN to ÉÉF to cover the cost of the program.
- 3- International students of our credited program pay between \$7200 CAN and \$8900 CAN (cost varies whether the student chooses the 9 credits or 12 credits program).
