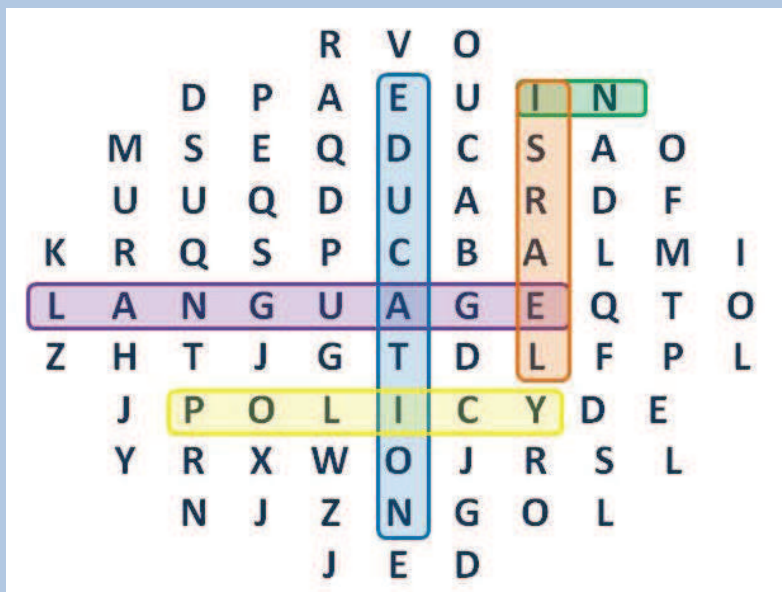

## Language (Education) Policy in Israel

The presentation will discuss central issues concerning Multilingual Language Policy and Planning in general and Educational Language Policy in particular. Israel is a multilingual and multicultural country that has and still is dealing with a linguistically, ethnically and culturally heterogenous population. As a case study, these issues will be illustrated with examples from Israel.

*Prof. Stavans is Associate Professor in Applied Linguistics in the English Department and Director of the Research Authority at Beit Berl Academic College (Israel) and a researcher in the Institute for Innovation in Education at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. Her research focuses on developmental and educational linguistics, trilingual acquisition and development, and cross-cultural and cross-linguistic literacy development.*

*Prof. Stavans is the author of numerous articles on topics such as code-switching, narrative input and development, immigrant bilingualism, educational language policy, parent-child interaction, and multiliteracy development. She is involved in international collaborations on language and literacy development in early multilingualism.*
