

Plant part labels and functions



This part of the plant takes in water and nutrients from the soil. It also holds the plant in the soil.

Roots

This part of the plant uses sunlight, water and carbon dioxide to make a sugar for food.



Stem

Leaves

This part of the plant takes up water from the soil and holds the plant upright.

This is the part of the plant where seeds are made- through pollination. Male cells- pollen (produced on the stamen) land on the stigma and grow down the style to the female cells called ovules. The pollen has to reach the ovules for the plant to produce seeds.



This part of the plant allows oxygen to leave the plant.
