

Food waste

Part 1: Individual long-turn

You take part in an international student conference on food waste problems. You have been asked to give a talk about food waste in the household.

In your talk you should

- describe how food is wasted in Austrian households (Chart 1)
- explain why people might waste so much food
- analyse why food waste is an environmental problem

You should talk for about 5 minutes.



Part 2: Interaction

In a conference break you get involved in a discussion of some members of the audience about concepts to cope with the problems of food waste.

In the discussion you should

- point out how food waste can be reduced at home and in the distribution chain
- give examples how unspoilt food can be used meaningfully (Chart 2)
- discuss strategies for the industry to reduce food waste (Chart 3)

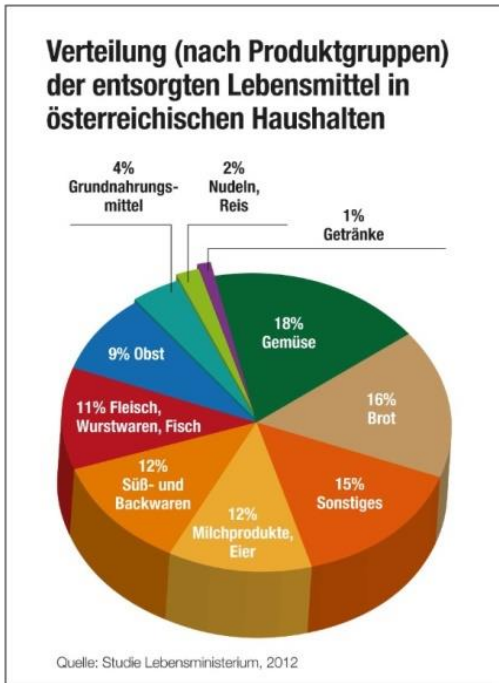
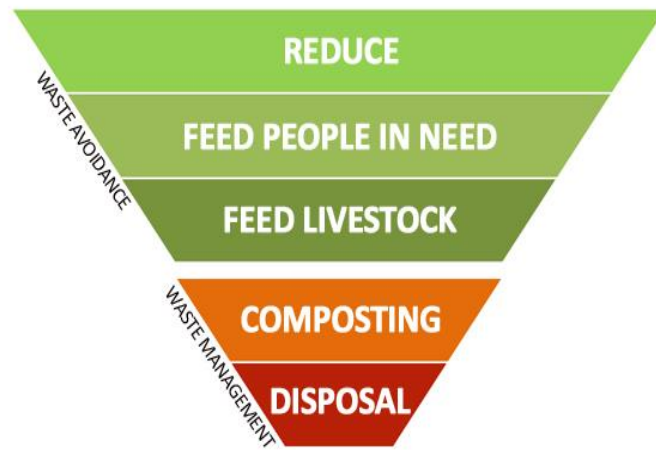
