

## Assistant Professor Microeconomics at Innsbruck University

Applications are invited for a postdoctoral researcher position at the Department of Economics of the University of Innsbruck. The University of Innsbruck offers an exciting work environment and excellent research facilities, including a well-equipped laboratory for conducting experiments. Its Economics Department ranks among the top ten departments in the German speaking world. Several department members are involved in research in game theory, mechanism design, behavioral economics and experimental economics. The postdoctoral position is for 4 years and will be under the supervision of Professor Markus Walzl. The earliest start date is February, 1st 2012. The position involves a 4 hours/week teaching obligation.

### Requirements

The successful candidate is expected to possess

- a Ph.D in Economics (or another subject with strong mathematical background);
- a solid background in theoretical microeconomics;
- an excellent research record in microeconomics;
- a strong commitment to pursue an academic career and the capacity to publish in top-rated academic journals;
- own ideas and initiative for developing research.

A knowledge of German is not a prerequisite.

Application deadline is January 11th, 2012. Applications should include

- a cover letter;
- a detailed CV containing the names and mail addresses of at least two referees;
- at least one letter of recommendation;
- at least one research paper.
