

Advisory Council Elections - Covid-19 Regulations

The election officers are asked to observe these regulations, to make them known to all eligible voters when they are invited to vote (by sending them along or by providing a link to access them) and to post them at the building entrances and at the entrance to the polling station. For all participants in the elections, the following regulations apply from entering the university building until leaving it:

1. Maintaining a minimum distance of one meter from other people.
2. Wearing a face mask that you have brought with you. If it is necessary to verify the identity of those entitled to vote, the election supervisors can order that the mouth and nose protection be removed briefly. During removal a minimum distance of 1.5 meters must be maintained.
3. Separate entrances are to be provided for entry and exit from the polling station, and entries and exits are to be regulated so that the minimum distance is not exceeded.
4. When entering the polling station, hands must be cleaned with disinfectant.
5. Those entitled to vote are asked to bring their own pen to tick. If this is forgotten, disinfected pens are available at the polling station. There is no pen in the voting booth itself during these elections.
6. The voting furniture (voting booths or voting desks with privacy screens, tables, ballot boxes) and all other contact points with which the eligible voters come into contact must be disinfected regularly before and during the election. If necessary, the election supervisors can briefly interrupt the election for this process.
7. Before the start of the election and during the election, the polling station must be ventilated at least every hour for at least three minutes, unless the premises are mechanically ventilated.
