Vladimir Shmalii is Associate Professor of Systematic Theology at the Postgraduate School of the Russian Orthodox Church in Moscow (Russia) and was the Vice Rector of this School from 2009 until 2015. He has lectured on dogmatic theology, christology and philosophy and anthropology at different theological academies in Russia since 1997. As Research fellow and Theological Consultant at the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate (1997-2009) and as Secretary of the Russian Orthodox Church Holy Synod Biblical and Theological Commission (1998 – 2015), he has been involved in the Russian Orthodox Church’s engagement with the World Council of Churches, a worldwide inter-church organization founded in 1948. He collaborates with the Faith and Order Commission of the WCC and was involved in the writing of the document “Moral Discernment in the Churches”.
