For this project we are searching for a PhD-candidate willing to work in a highly motivated team on joint research projects in the field of experimental economics.

Your duties

- To contribute to the above-mentioned project by designing, planning, and conducting experiments.
- To do statistical data analysis.
- To present the research findings at international conferences.
- To publish studies in internationally reputable academic journals.

Details and requirements

- Master degree (or close to completion) in Economics, Business Administration, or cognate disciplines with an excellent track record.
- Ability to work both independently and as a part of a team.
- Experience in applying empirical research methods.
- Willingness to use appropriate software, including software for statistical data analysis (e.g. Stata) and for implementing experimental studies (e.g. zTree, oTree).
- Fluent communication skills (writing and presenting) in English and German.
- Gross salary per month (14 times a year): EUR 2.148,40.
- The position is available as of September 1, 2019 or later.
- The position is initially for 2 years. A third-party grant proposal which would provide funding for up to additional 2 years will be submitted.
