

Conference Dinner at the “Arzler Alm”

General Information

The Arzler Alm is at an altitude of 1.067m above the roofs of Innsbruck. The starting point for the walk is the parking lot of the “Nordkettenbahn”. Time required: 40 min, Difference in Altitude: app. 200 m, Length: app. 4 km.

Walk to the Arzler Alm

We will arrange a **shuttle bus** for the trip to the lower terminus of the Nordkettenbahn (Hungerburg Bahn). The bus will wait in front of the University and will leave at **17:30**.

You can take several paths to hike up, like the “Waldsteig” No. 218 (time required: 40 min) or the “Rosnerweg” (Arzler Alm Weg – 60 min). All paths are signposted.

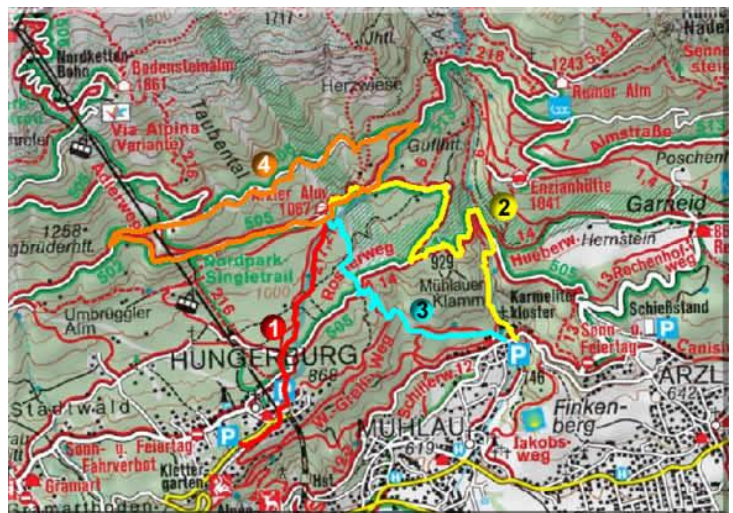
Return

There is a **shuttle bus** organized for your way back. The bus will leave at **22:00** at the parking lot of the “Nordkettenbahn”.

Otherwise you can take public buses (time table see below) and do not forget flashlights because the path is not lighted. (Sunset is at 21:08)

Timetable Bus Line J or N7 (Nightliner) – IVB Bus stop “Theresienkirche” in direction of Marktplatz:

J: 20:56, 21:26, 21:56, 22:26 then N7 (Nightliner): 22:58, 23:28, 23:58, 00:28 (last bus)



By Car to Hungerburg

Drive through Innsbruck to the Hungerburg (the whole way is signed). There is a free parking area at the “Sparmarkt Hungerburg”, approximately 200 m before the lower terminus of the Nordkettenbahn.
