### From the train station to the SOWI campus:

When traveling by train, get off at the main station called Innsbruck Hauptbahnhof. From there take either a taxi or walk as follows: Exit the main station and take a right until you meet Museumstrasse. Take a left onto Museumstrasse. Take your first right onto Sillgasse. Follow the street past the first cross-road and you will be in the courtyard of the university. This walk takes approximately 10 minutes.
