You will see a famous Red Square, The Kremlin and Old Arbat Street in Moscow; newly-constructed Kazan Kremlin, places of the World Summer Universiade 2013; Cathedral-on-the-Blood, Ganina Yama and several boards between Europe and Asia in Yekaterinburg; the 18th century churches, brightly painted shutters and log houses decorated with wooden lacework and the world's oldest and deepest freshwater lake – Lake Baikal in Irkutsk; see port, Golden Horn bridge and the Russkiy island in Vladivostok.
