Essential Responsibilities:

- Monthly accounts payable accrual analysis and reconciliation (Goods Received Not Invoiced / GRNI). Preparation of the reconciliation to general ledger, aging analysis, drilldown and investigation of specific items to allow resolution or cleaning where necessary. This covers our Austrian HQ, plus international subsidiaries. Involves working with various internal departments and external suppliers
- Monthly and quarterly financial inventory close activities for our various stock locations, working with the Inventory Accountant. Oracle ledger bookings and reclasses, financial reserves and adjustments, account reconciliations, reporting
