Management Accounting as Social and Organizational Practice

14th Workshop, 21-22 April 2022, Stockholm

We are pleased to announce the fourteenth Workshop on Management Accounting as Social and Organizational Practice (MASOP), to be held **from April 21st to April 22nd 2022** in Stockholm. The aim of the workshop is to bring together scholars in the field of management accounting and control who share an interest in understanding the social and organizational antecedents and effects of management accounting practice.

As in previous years, the workshop seeks to develop participants' research through critical discussion and to provide a forum for debate of emerging ideas and developments in practice and research. The workshop will feature 12 paper presentations (45 minutes each) and one plenary session. It is limited to 40 participants. Participants other than those presenting a paper are accepted on a first come-first served basis. The deadline for **registration** is **March 14th, 2022**.

Submission of papers:

Participants who would like to present a paper should let us know as early as possible. Please include in the e-mail the names and e-mail addresses of all co-authors, but do not mention author details on the paper itself (i.e., attach an anonymized version). The deadline for **submission of full papers** is **January 31st, 2022**. Papers will be reviewed and notification of acceptance (or otherwise) will be given in February. Preference will be given to papers that relate closely to the theme of the workshop. We aim to create a balanced overall program, in terms of different theories/methodologies and a mix between emerging and more established scholars.

Practicalities:

Venue: The workshop will take place at Stockholm School of Economics, Sveavägen 65, Stockholm. It starts 9am on Thursday morning and will finish at around 4pm on Friday. There are no fees. The workshop is planned to be on site in Stockholm. In case travel restrictions or other government restrictions related to Covid-19 should prevent us from holding the workshop on site, we will move to a virtual format on the same dates.
