# Management Accounting as Social and Organizational Practice

London, 20-21 April, 2015

We are pleased to announce the eight Workshop on Management Accounting as Social and Organizational Practice (MASOP), to be held from 20 April to 21 April 2015 in London. The aim of the workshop is to bring together scholars in the field of management accounting and control who share an interest in understanding the social and organizational antecedents and effects of management accounting practice.

As in previous years, the workshop seeks to develop participants' research through critical discussion and to provide a forum for debate of emerging ideas and developments in practice and research. The workshop will feature 12 paper presentations (45 minutes each) and one plenary session. It is limited to 50 participants.

## Submission of papers

The deadline for **submission of full papers** is **January 12, 2015**. Please include names and email addresses for all authors on submitted papers. Papers will be reviewed and notification of acceptance (or otherwise) will be given by end of January. Preference will be given to papers that relate closely to the theme of the workshop. We aim to create a balanced overall program, in terms of different theories/methodologies and a mix between emerging and more established scholars.

## Registration

The corresponding authors of accepted papers are automatically registered for the workshop. We will also offer places to all co-authors of accepted papers. Registration for all other participants will open on **February 23, 2015** and will be accepted via a registration website (to be notified) on a first come, first served basis until all remaining places are filled.

## Practicalities:

The workshop will take place at the London School of Economics and Political Science. It starts first thing Monday morning and will finish at around 4pm on Tuesday afternoon. There are no fees.
