

Current project status

The Erasmus+ project GoodVET continues to work intensively to achieve the project objectives. The project partners from the four countries regularly exchange information and successively achieve further milestones of the project goals.

The project partners were able to examine the five "Best Practice" measures more closely and in the meantime also have met with all responsible persons of the respective measures in order to obtain constructive criticism of the beta version of the analysis tool.

A prepared presentation of all best practice examples with respective assignments to selected quality indicators can be found on the project homepage in the national languages (German, Danish, Italian) of the project partners, as well as in English.

In February, the project partners got together for the last time at a transnational project meeting in Cologne. In the conversations held on site, feedback from the practical actors could be exchanged and entered into the beta version. All indicators were again scrutinized and critically reflected with regard to meaningfulness and target group orientation. At this point, the different feedbacks of the associated partners could also be presented and discussed about the beta version of the analysis tool.

In addition, future organizational and administrative assignments were discussed and recorded among the project partners at the meeting in Cologne.

The results of the transnational meeting were documented and translated into further work packages for the coming months. These include the optimisation of some quality indicators and

the production and publication of the final version of the supranational handbook.



Outlook

The supranational handbook represents the first of three intellectual outputs and is expected to be completed by mid-April. The "Best Practice" examples will also be finalised and made available online at the end of April. Thus, interested practice actors can already inform themselves about the results and make use of them.

The final output will be the creation of the online analysis tool.
