

Responsibility to Protect: A Canadian Heritage.

In November 2009 the Canadian Studies Centre at the University of Innsbruck in cooperation with the Africa Focus of the Institute of Contemporary History organized an international and interdisciplinary symposium on "Responsibility to Protect: A Canadian Heritage. Peacekeeping, Diplomacy, Media, and Literature Responding to Humanitarian Challenges".

"Responsibility to Protect", a Canadian invention, is intended to successfully counteract the international community's powerlessness and failure to act in the face of crises and humanitarian catastrophes. Originally established in peacekeeping, R2P also involves other areas of operation such as diplomacy, media, and literature, whose specific contributions can be defined as "need to debate" (diplomacy), "necessity to inform" (media), and "courage to transcend" (literature).
