„Migration and asylum law in Italy: the fundamental rights of migrants“

The lecture focuses on Italian legislation and case law about the rights of migrants in Italy, starting from the analysis of Article 10 of the Italian Constitution. The condition of migrants in Italy will be explored, taking into consideration the different status of each category of migrants: asylum seekers, international protection holders, labor migrants, unaccompanied minors, irregular migrants, etc. Particular attention will be devoted to the relationship between welfare and immigration through the analysis of the conditions of enjoyment of social rights to foreigners (health, social assistance, education, housing).
