Criteria and requirements

- The prize serves in particular the promotion of young academics.
- Eligible for submission are diploma and master theses, dissertations and PhD theses in the area of gender studies, women's and gender research.
- Outstanding interdisciplinary work is particularly eligible.
- The thesis has been completed at the University of Innsbruck within the past two years (key date 1st of January 2017).
- A thesis can be submitted for the prize only once.
- Documents needed for submission:
 - Single copy of thesis (spiral binding or hardback)
 - Digital copy of thesis (via e-mail to: gender-studies@uibk.ac.at)
 - Short biography including contact details (**postal address, email address, and telephone number**)
 - Short summary of the content of the thesis (500 words)
 - Information about previous awards and prizes if applicable
 - (Dissertation/ PhD theses: including an expertise).

The prize will be scientifically supervised by a committee drawn from members of the research platform gender studies at the University of Innsbruck www.uibk.ac.at/geschlechterforschung

Deadline for submission: Tuesday, 11th of June 2019
