

International Society of Limnology (SIL) Wetzel Memorial Fund SIL Congress Travel Award

Information on the Wetzel Memorial Fund

The Wetzel Memorial Fund was created in 2004 through a request from Robert G. Wetzel. As one of Professor Wetzel's highest priorities, the fund will be used to pay SIL-related expenses of young limnologists throughout the world that might otherwise be unable to participate in SIL activities. In particular, the Wetzel Memorial Fund will be used for partial travel support of those SIL members who are presenting a paper (orally or by poster) at SIL congress meetings.

For the 2018 Congress in China, awards from the Wetzel Memorial Fund will be of \$500. USD per individual.

Candidates must comply with the following criteria:

- Have been a SIL member in the year prior to the Congress (in this case, 2017. This restriction does not apply to graduate students).
- Make a presentation at the Congress
- Previous award recipients are not eligible to reapply.

Graduate Students from Asia are requested to apply for support from the Congress Organizers who have obtained funding for Registration and Accommodation for 10 students.

Applications must include a title and abstract of the proposed presentation.

The abstract should be of high caliber indicating the purpose of the study and providing a careful summary of the critical results. Additionally, a brief paragraph is requested that summarizes the applicant's career with a list of publications below. Please indicate your plans to raise the rest of the monies required. In the case of graduate students and postdoctoral fellows, a letter from the supervisor must accompany the application. The letter should indicate that the applicant has financial need and that he/she supports of applicant's attending the Congress.

The award recipient must file a brief report preferably within 1 month after congress, on experiences gained from participating in the SIL congress. These reports or parts of them will be published in SILNews and/or posted on the SIL Website and Facebook page. Photographs will be welcome.

Recipients will be chosen by lottery from acceptable entries by the SIL awards committee.
