1. **Dualism:** Digital technology can connect us, but it can also divide us.
2. **Authority:** How digital platforms influence traditional institutions and power structures.
3. **Attention:** Understanding this new currency of the digital economy.
4. **Abundance:** How digital environments differ from anything before.
