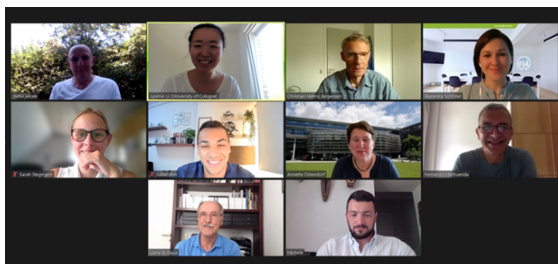


Current activities: Online tool

The project partners are currently working on the creation of the online training tool. In the first transnational meeting in Cologne, the structure of the tool was already defined. The partners are currently working on the storylines for the individual indicators to be filled with content. In addition, individual storylines are already being developed for the media. One component of the online tool will be videos, which will be created using special software. The purpose of the videos is to present the contents of the respective indicator to the target group in an easily understandable, appealing and user-friendly manner. In addition, a didactic reduction to the most important aspects of the respective indicators for the evaluators took place by video production by means of appropriate software. Thus, a very practice-oriented representation should be made possible. The extensive contents of the online tool were divided fairly among all four partner-teams. The teams are currently working in tandems to increase the efficiency of the development of the tool.

On July 19, 2022, the next digital project meeting was held, attended by all project partners. The meeting was explicitly dedicated to the further development of the online tool.



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Partners presented their approach to the quality indicators they have worked on so far and exchanged ideas with other team members. Critical friends of the project were also present and enriched the plenary with their feedback and contributions. The importance of embedding the quality indicators in the evaluation framework was emphasized, as well as the need for a common understanding of terms such as "evidence" for each step of the online tool. The meeting was a supportive activity to help partners better navigate the theoretical framework in the process of creating practical content for the online tool. The meeting served as preparation for another online meeting planned for September 2022 and for the second transnational meeting in Bergamo in November 2022.

Outlook

All project partners are already looking forward to the second transnational project meeting in Bergamo. At this meeting, the elaborations of the online tool will be compiled, but also the supplementary manual and the toolbox will be discussed.
