

Information sheet habilitation according to § 103 UG 2002

The application for the venia docendi as a private lecturer according to § 103 UG 2002 must be submitted in advance to the Rector's Office (Office of the Vice-Rector for Research) in digital form in pdf format.

In addition, the application including your original signature and a printout (unbound) of the habilitation thesis are required.

Please note the specified designations for the electronic documents.

Required Documents:

- Application (LastName_Habil_Applikation.pdf) with exact designation of the habilitation subject (please send the application with original signature or hand it in personally)

 one copy in printed form (double-sided, no binding necessary)
- If more than one author was involved in the submitted Habilitation thesis, a Statement indicating the applicant's share of such work. (LastName_Habil_Share_Work.pdf)

- List of other scientific achievements (LastName Habil Scientific.pdf)
- List of **courses held** (LastName_Habil_Courses.pdf): Multiple teaching assignments at accredited postsecondary educational institutions to demonstrate teaching skills. (type, number, duration and institution)
 - ("...A multiple teaching activity is given if teaching events were held several times and over a longer period of time. Repeated lecturing activity is NOT sufficient. Failure to meet the requirement shall result in rejection of the application." (according to UG 2002/§103 ErläuterutRV 09)

It is recommended to bring also the following documents:

- Confirmation/endorsement by the dean of the relevant faculty
- For further proof of didactic skills, results of course evaluations, proof of completed university didactic training and continuing education and/or similar can be submitted.

According to the Gebührengesetz 1957/§14, a fee is due after submission of the application. You will receive notification of the amount of this fee after submission of the habilitation.
