

Course Requirements for General Language Courses

1. Objectives

The assessment in general language courses is based on a standardised final test. The aim is to comprehensively assess the language skills acquired during the course.

2. Structure of the final test

The final test consists of a written and an oral exam.

Skills	Description
Listening comprehension	Understanding spoken language in various contexts
Reading comprehension	Understanding written texts in various contexts
Writing	Independent production of written texts
Speaking	Oral expression and participation in conversations

3. Assessment

To achieve a positive grade, each skill must be passed; a pass is defined as a score of 60 per cent or higher. One skill may be as low as 50 per cent provided that the other three skills have each achieved a score of more than 60 per cent.

4. Grading

The grade is based solely on the final test. Class participation and homework are expected, but do not count towards the grade.
