


Pollen monitoring report Galtür

The pollen season is starting in Galtür!



IN A NUTSHELL

At the elevation of Galtür, the allergenic risk remains low.

We will keep you informed of any developments.


Our pollen measurements have officially started for the season in Galtür. From now on, we will provide weekly updates on the local pollen situation.

Tyrol overview: Birch pollen is moderate in Tyrolean valleys, with the peak of the season likely past in lower areas. Cross-reactive pollen from hornbeam and oak may intensify symptoms in persons sensitive to birch pollen. Ash pollen remains low to moderate, plane trees are blooming, causing moderate to high pollen loads along avenues and streets lined with these trees, and grass pollen is starting to appear.

Galtür situation: In contrast to the lower valley conditions in Tyrol, the

situation at higher elevations like Galtür is currently much more favorable. Pollen levels remain low, and the allergenic burden is minimal for now. However, localized moderate allergenic levels may occur at lower elevations.
