- » 27.583 students (51% international students)
- » 5.629 staff (academic/non-academic)

 - 4 hours to Vienna, 5 hours to Venice

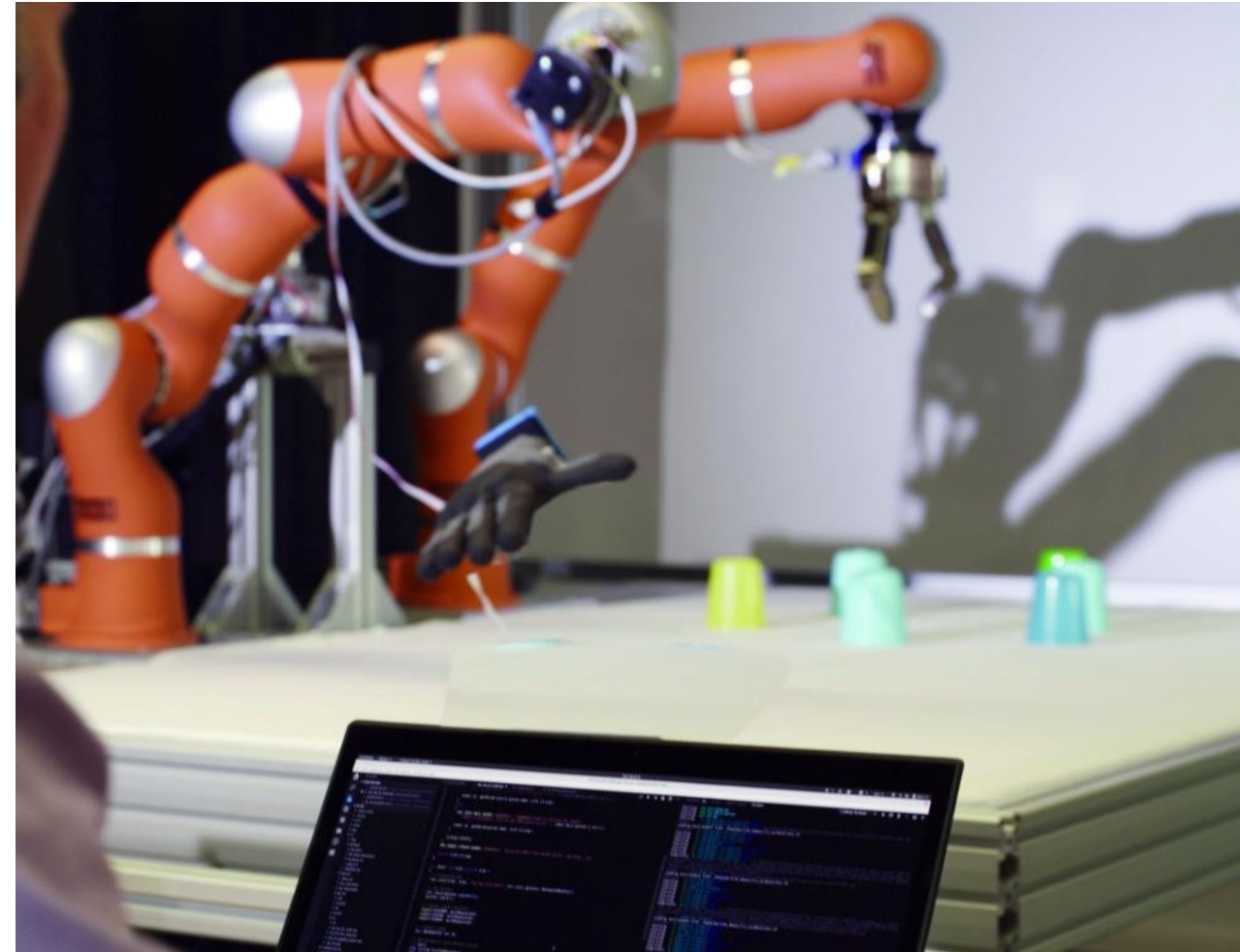

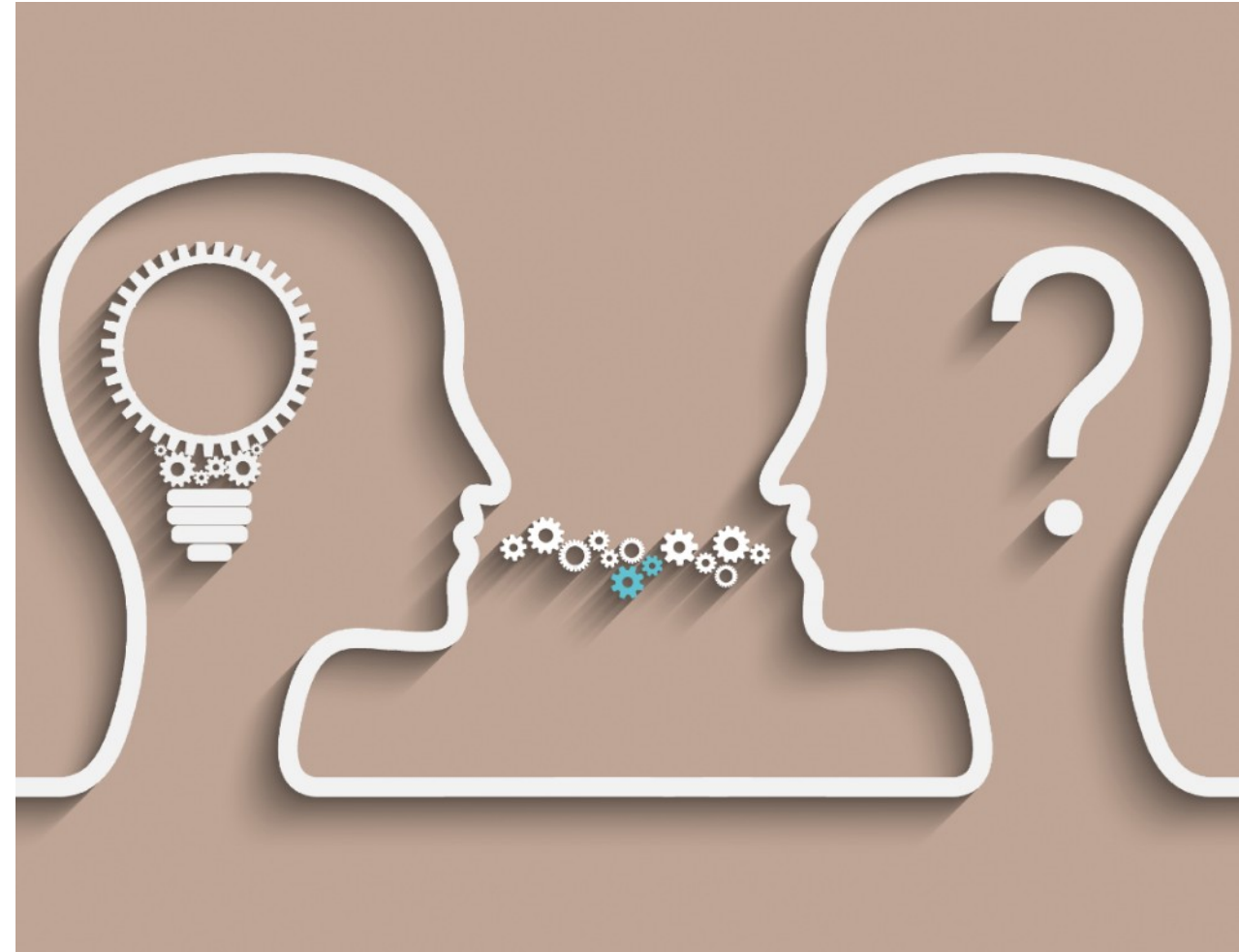

- 2) Check of General University Entrance Qualification done by the relevant examiner
- 3) Enrollment during the admission period

FAQs Admission

What happens after I have submitted my application?

1. Processing

- only complete applications are processed
- only one, prioritized application is processed
- Check of formal admission criteria:
 - official final form Bachelor's Diploma (degree certificate) and detailed transcript of records
 - with translation into German or English by a sworn translator
 - with correct legalization, either double authentication or apostille
 - Proof of Language proficiency

2. Check of General University Entrance Qualification by the relevant examiner

3. Either Letter of Improvement, Admission or Refusal

FAQs Admission

I have not completed my Bachelor's study programme yet - may I already apply for a Master's programme?

No, as the final transcript/Diploma Supplement has to be uploaded. (Exception, if currently studying at the LFUI). Get in contact with the admission department.

Non-EEA:

I will not have graduated until the end of the application period, May 15th or Oct 15th.
What should I do?

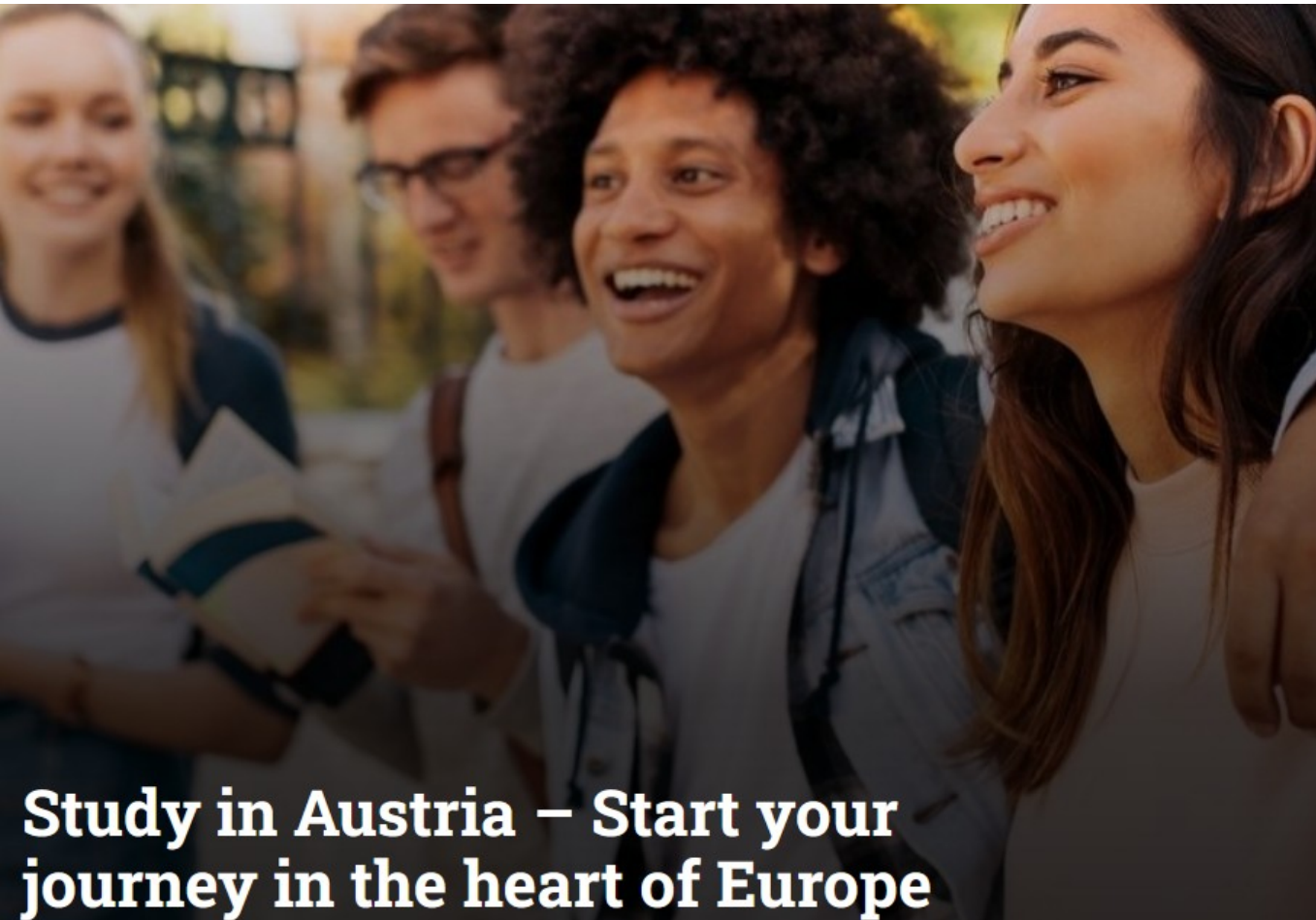
Upload a confirmation issued by your university, stating the expected date of graduation. The actual certificate and the final transcript have to be submitted as soon as possible after.

FAQs Admission

How long does it take until I receive a notification?

The processing of applications is done in order of arrival and can take up to several weeks, depending on completeness, check of General University Entrance Qualification, mailing originals.
