### General notes about the FLD

The "Forschungsleistungsdokumentation" (FLD) is the research information system (FIS/CRIS) of the University of Innsbruck. On the one hand, data from the FLD form the basis for the university's annual intellectual capital statement; on the other hand, various key figures and reports are created from the data sets, which are used both internally (e.g. evaluations, target agreements, development agreements) and externally.

With currently over 100 types, the FLD tries to live up to the broad spectrum of the University of Innsbruck as a comprehensive university and to adequately reflect the research-related activities of its employees. However, not all types and categories of services are equally relevant for every subject area.

Despite or perhaps because of the large number of types available, the correct classification of services provided is not always straight forward. This handbook is intended to provide assistance in the classification and recording of research-related services in the FLD.

After a listing of all categories and types in the table of contents, this document provides the definitions of the individual service types as well as specific examples of their recording in tabular form. The thematic structure is based on that within the VIS application 'Forschungsleistungsdokumentation', which is used to record new FLD-entries.

The following aspects require special attention when recording services:

### **Employment or ongoing doctoral studies**

The FLD records the achievements of persons with an active employment status at the University of Innsbruck. In addition, the achievements of emeritus or retired professors and of active doctoral students without employment are recorded. The period of service and the period of employment at the university must overlap. In the case of publications, the date of publication counts. For scientific publication types, those achievements that are accepted for publication in the last year of employment are taken into account.

### Affiliation with the University of Innsbruck

Persons with an upright employment relationship are obliged to name the University of Innsbruck as their affiliation in accordance with the applicable <u>affiliation guidelines</u>. Checking the correct affiliation is part of the validation process within the FLD. Achievements without an affiliation with the University of Innsbruck cannot be considered for evaluations, which can result in a disadvantage for both the university and the person in question. Any services provided as part of private-sector or other activities outside the scope of employment at the University of Innsbruck are not recorded in the FLD.

### Research focus and own contribution

The term 'Forschungsleistungsdokumentation' (= research performance documentation) implies both a given research focus and the existence of one's own performance / contribution. These are two prerequisites that must be met for each data set recorded. The research reference is understood relatively broadly. In addition to the classic categories of 'publications' and 'lectures', the FLD spectrum also includes certain services for the scientific community, activities in the area of academic self-administration, and committee work in connection with the personal scientific research. In addition, there are activities in the area of the 'third mission', in which aspects of one's own research field are made accessible and understandable to a broader public. Teaching activities, on the other hand, are not considered in the FLD.

### Relevance

Relevant in the sense of the FLD are achievements (except for academic self-administration) in connection with the dissemination of research-related content. This implies that the target audience goes beyond the everyday work and cooperation environment of the person providing the service. In the lectures category, these are services provided as part of events structured by a fixed programme, in front of an at least partially external audience.

However, achievements in working group and institute retreats or administrative project meetings, seminar presentations at one's own institute, or similar are not relevant for the FLD. Likewise, mere memberships in associations and other interest groups or professional organisations in which there is no direct active creative role related to scientific work are not relevant.

### Information on recording services

The following is an overview of the most important information on data recording in the FLD. Detailed information can be found in the 'Data Collection Manual', which is available on our <u>website</u> within the <u>FLD-FAQs</u>.

### Timing of data recording and FLD deadlines

Research achievments should be continually recorded in the FLD. However, it is important that all services provided in a calendar year are recorded by about mid-January of the following year so that these services (mainly scientific publications and lectures) can be included in the annual intellectual capital report (Wissensbilanz). The corresponding deadline is communicated by email to all FLD-authorised persons and the heads of institutes.

In general, achievements may only be recorded in the FLD after (or during, in the case of ongoing achievements) full accomplishment. Publications can only be recorded in the FLD after the metadata (e.g. title, page size, ISBN, permanent link, DOI, etc.) of the publication are available. The only exception to this rule are assistant professors undergoing performance evaluation as part of their qualification agreement: in this case, publications accepted for publication will be included in the FLD upon presentation of appropriate evidence.

### Recording the persons involved

The persons involved in recorded services are entered according to the following scheme: surname1, first name1; surname2, first name2; ...,

All persons involved (authors) must always be entered in the correct order (especially for publications and lectures). If more than ten people are involved, an abbreviated author format can be used: The first three authors are recorded, followed by '..., ...; 'as a placeholder. This is followed by all (further) authors with an affiliation to the University of Innsbruck, again followed by '; et al.'. An example:

### The different statuses in the FLD

In the FLD, records are given the following six statuses: 'Erfassung Institut', 'Abschluss Institut', 'Abschluss FLD', 'zur Kontrolle Institut', 'Kontrolliert Institut' und 'gelöscht'. Achievements in all statuses are visible and editable for the administrators. However, in most cases, processing takes place from the 'Abschluss Institut' status. In particular, publications and lectures are checked for complete metadata and the correct classification of the service. If anything is unclear, the service is set to the status 'Zur Kontrolle Institut', which results in an automated notification to the respective FLD-authorised person. The response to the query can be sent by email to <a href="fld@uibk.ac.at">fld@uibk.ac.at</a> or by making a note in the comment field of the record. In both cases, the FLD administration will receive a notification and will process the record.

### **Ongoing services**

Ongoing services (e.g. editorships of periodicals, certain functions and memberships) are recorded with the respective start date and with the end date '31.12.9999', or, in the case of a year as the end date, with '9999'.

### Assignments to the university's Research Focus System

Assignments to the units of the research focus system and the doctoral programmes can be made via the 'FSP/FP/FZ/DK' input field. These assignments can also be changed retrospectively by the persons involved via the VIS application 'Meine Forschung'. The system automatically assigns records related to research centres and doctoral programmes that are assigned to a research focus or research platform to the respective higher-level unit.

### **Scientific Publications**

### **Books and (Co-)Edited Books**

**∧** 

A work of literature written by one author or a group of authors, which is published within a single unit as a book.
In case of a group of authors the work is only to be counted as an autonomous publication (book), if responsibility for parts of the book is not explicitly attributed to individual authors. (cf. → Contributions to Books / Journals)

**Multi-volume items** are to be considered as **one book**, if each volume carries the **same ISBN number**. If the individual volumes carry different ISBN numbers, then each volume should be recorded as a separate book in the FLD.

### Anthology / Collected Edition, Scientific (Editorship) Definition Book compiled by one author or a group of authors containing scientific articles written by various authors, which present knowledge of a narrow scientific field and are directed at researchers (the scientific community) or other scientific contributions such as legal commentaries, contributions to yearbooks or almanacs, "Festschriften", loose-leaf folders etc. The authorship of individual contributions must be featured explicitly. Distinction against journals and other periodicals In contrast to journals, anthologies carry their own title as well as their own ISBN number. If an anthology is part of a series, the relevant details can be entered into the input-fields "Reihe" and "Reihennummer". Anthologies that are published as part of a series often have an ISBN number, which denotes the individual volume, as well as an ISSN, which identifies the series. 





In the case of a patent family, only the earliest patent application and the first international application are transferred to the FLD. Altogether, the following bibliographic fields will be transferred to and displayed in the FLD: Inventors Patent title Application number Application date Publication date Publication date

All patents from 2015 onwards, that are so far recorded in the FLD, are being replaced by the corresponding patent entries of the Intellectual Property Database. FLD patent entries until 2014



As soon as the entry is edited by the administrator, the ID of the record will appear in between pointed brackets. With that the record is marked as an "external anthology" and will not be taken into consideration for various reports.





### **Transfer-Oriented Publications and Media Contributions**

**Transfer-oriented Publications** prepare and reprocess scientific knowledge for a non-scientific, professional audience. In general, transfer-oriented publications are thought to link scientific theory with practical knowledge.

Publications written for the purpose of public outreach (public relations) are also to be recorded in this category. These kinds of publications are directed at the general public.

<u>Please note</u>: When recording transfer-oriented anthologies or collected editions, please note that there is no distinction between editorship and authorship in the category of transfer-oriented publications. The editorship of encyclopaedias and textbooks that contain contributions of various authors, thus is to be recorded in "Encyclopaedia, Transfer-Oriented" or "Schoolbook / Textbook, Non-Scientific"






