## **Wanderings of a Mountain Guide:**

The Letters of Conrad Kain, 1906-1933 Zac Robinson (University of Alberta)

In 1906, Conrad Kain (1884-1934), a mountain guide from Lower Austria, left Europe for an odyssey of adventure and climbing that took him around the world, ultimately to Canada. This talk examines this remarkable life, as well as Kain's literary aspirations, through a collection of private letters written by Kain to an early client from Reichenau an der Rax, Amelie Malek (1871-1941), who became a dear life-long friend.
