We wish you a symptom-free autumn and winter season and look forward to being able to provide information about the pollen situation in Obergurgl again next year.

The 2025 pollen season has now come to an end in Obergurgl and the region, as most plants have finished flowering, and our pollen traps across Tyrol are now only recording a few isolated pollen grains. The amounts in the air around Obergurgl are very low and no longer reach the irritation threshold.

This is our last weekly pollen report for 2025. We will continue to measure pollen levels during autumn and

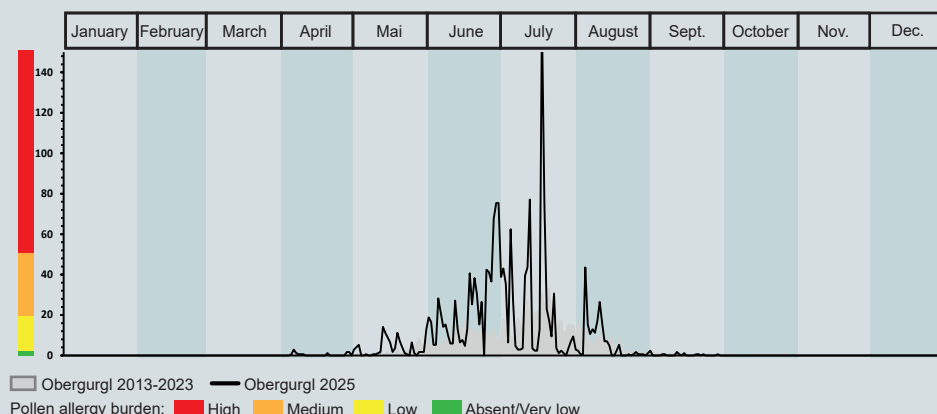
winter across Tyrol, and regular reports will resume in April 2026, when the first plants begin to flower in Obergurgl.
