Foreword by the Rector

I am pleased to provide a brief insight into the development of the University of Innsbruck over the past few years in this brochure.

Very positive developments can be seen in key areas in 2024. Examples are the increase in the number of active students to 66.5% and a further increase in the number of graduates to 4,364 in the past academic year. In the field of research, the number of publications increased by 3.1% last year (to 4,450 in absolute terms), as did third-party funding from the central funding institutions EU (+24.4%) and FWF (+4.2%).

The current political and economic situation suggests that we will face new challenges in the future. As Rector of the University of Innsbruck however, I am convinced that together we will succeed in continuing to create excellent conditions for high-quality research and teaching and thus


further consolidate the role of our alma mater as one of the largest and best-performing educational institutions in Austria.






Graduates Academic year 2023/24 per faculty



Degrees - Gender Ratio




Gender ratio of graduates in 2023/24




Long term development of budget







Long term development of third-party funding






Long term development of publications

71.3% of all Web of Science publications in 2024 were co-authored with international scholars 5,689 total



Professors per student






