Content:

With the rapidly growing availability of digital and digitized content, the notion and role of digital archives has undergone significant changes. Machine reading technologies offer automated analysis of media documents, dynamic visualization tools provide users with contextual perspectives, while innovative digital tools foster new forms of social user interaction and collaboration and enable users to create meaning in novel ways. MIT's Active Archives Initiative explores new approaches for engaging with digital archives for research and education in the humanities and social sciences.

Dr. Kurt Fendt is Principal Research Associate in Comparative Media Studies/ Writing and Global Studies and Languages at Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Director of MIT's Active Archive initiative. For more than two decades he was Executive Director of HyperStudio, MIT's Digital Humanities Lab. Fendt teaches graduate and undergraduate seminars in Media Studies, Digital Humanities, and German Studies.
