John Martin Fischer (Riverside, CA) Towards a Solution to the Luck Problem

Building on previous work, I provide the fundamentals of an answer to the "luck problem" for libertarianism. My solution to this problem employs resources that I have invoked to argue for the compatibility of moral responsibility and causal determinism. Both sides of the determinism problem can then be addressed in a similar way.
