- academic output beyond the PhD thesis;
- experience as post-doc researcher or relevant professional experience.
- experience in the application for third-party funding and the implementation of third-party-funded projects;
- experience in academic mobility;
- didactic competence (indicated by student evaluations);
- social competence;
- proficiency in German and English;
- applications have to include a comprehensive concept on research and teaching;
