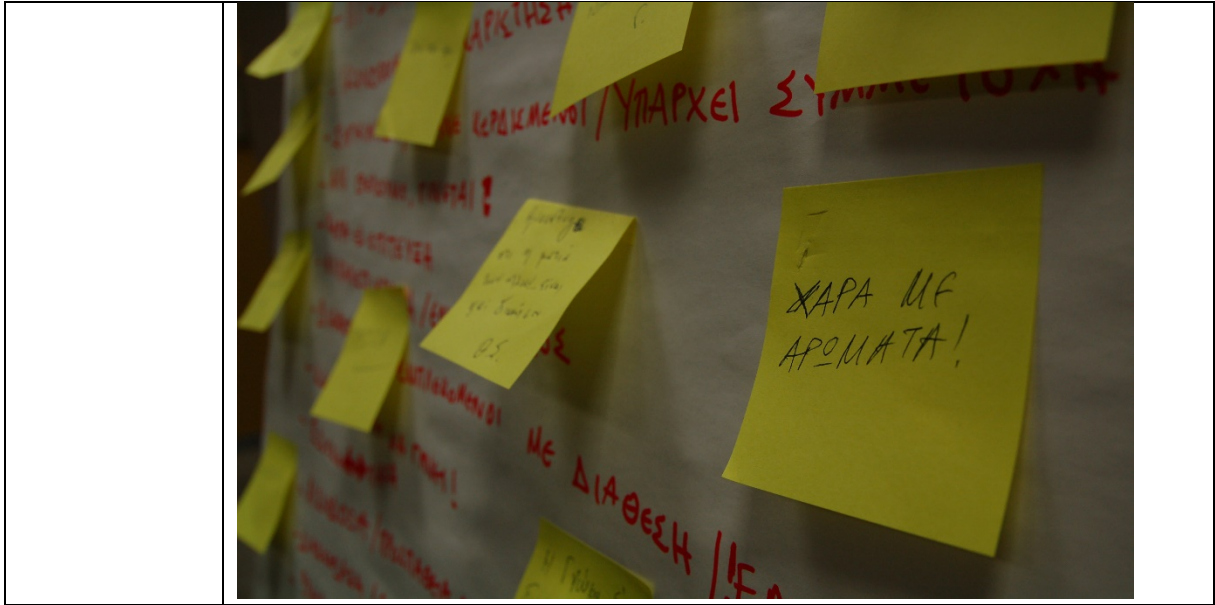


	Science Café Number 4: 7 eyeglasses of co-creation. 10/4/2017
Which topic was addressed?	Food security and Greek phylogenetic resources
How many people attended?	18
Who were they?	The President of the Chefs of Northern Greece, two University Campus chefs, restaurant owners, farmers, food processing and marketing entrepreneurs, researchers from the pharmaceutical, Medicinal-Aromatic Plants, food technology and food quality controls, and a representative of the social and solidarity agriculture.
Goals and questions	
Which goals did you want to achieve?	Create a common sense of purpose Enhance BBGK profile as a discussion center for food security issues
How did you find out whether you were on the right track?	Participants asked us to build and maintain a network in order to taking things forward.
Agenda and experience	
What did you do?	After ice breaking with a funny game based on Medicinal Aromatic Plants, the participants were divided into two groups and were successively wearing 5 glasses of different colors. Each color represents something different, e.g. the green color is the new ideas and the red color is the feeling. From a different "view" at all times, they recorded and discussed their views on Greek phylogenetic resources and nutritional assurance.
What went well?	The co-creation session strengthened the participants' confidence and sense that they are not 'alone'. The Garden could capitalise on this as people seem to be 'thirsty' for events that relate to their interests and that can also create a sense of community.
What would you recommend to do differently next time?	Some alternative approaches to getting people to writing their ideas on paper.
