TCI goes to the grassroots: Experience from India Dr. Thomas Abraham / Dr. Matthias Scharer

India is a developing country. It is also a rich country of poor people. A number of agencies are engaged in "empowering the weaker sections". Most of them forget that "power" is from within, and that boundaries are expandable. Panackachira is a South Indian village where common people are learning to use TCI forself discovery and boundary-expansion. The leaders of this workshop, Thomas and Matthias, are closely associated with this village, and they will share with you the dynamics of working with TCI in a village set up.
