

Ulrich Brückner



Ulrich Brückner studied Political Science, German Literature and History at the University of Würzburg and the Freie Universität Berlin. Since 1987 he is specialized on European integration. From 1992 until 2002 Uli Brückner worked at the FU Berlin as lecturer and later as the Jean Monnet chair, an EU program for teaching activities in the field of European Integration. His Ph.D. is on the role of the European Commission in the policy-making of the EU. From 1997 until 2003 he also worked as a Jean Monnet visiting professor at Szczecin University in Poland. Together with Michael Bolle he applied successfully for a Jean Monnet Center of Excellence in 1998. Since 1999 Uli Brückner taught as visiting professor at Stanford University Berlin and California, ECNU Shanghai and MGIMO Moscow. 2003 he became EU Jean Monnet Professor at Stanford and works in California in spring and in the Berlin program in fall / winter. His current fields of interests are institutional developments in the EU, external affairs and Eastward enlargement.
