

Course Requirements for General Language Courses

Final exam

- Listening, reading, writing and speaking (in terms of taking part in a discussion) are the receptive and productive skill areas assessed in the final exam.
- The final test consists of a written and an oral examination.
- Every skill area must have at least 60 per cent for the candidate to obtain a positive grade.
- One skill area may only have 50 per cent if in the other three skill areas more than 60 per cent has been reached. The total average of all individual skill areas must be at least 60 per cent.
- The grade in the final test is decisive for the grade in the certificate. Cooperation in class and homework are required but do not count towards the grade.
