Building a Consensus: The Case of Israel Law of the Dying Patient

The topic of treating dying patients is of paramount importance from many points of view. Deep controversies have taken place on various practices suggested under the title of "Euthanasia".

The lecture will describe the process of drafting the Israeli Law of the Dying Patient, in a public committee led by the speaker and others. It will serve as an example of how to reach a broad overlapping consensus on debated issues.

Prof. Asa Kasher is the Laura Schwarz-Kipp Professor Emeritus of Professional Ethics and Philosophy of Practice and Professor Emeritus of Philosophy at Tel Aviv University. He is a member of Israel Bioethics Council and has been head or member of numerous public and governmental committees in medical ethics, military ethics and other areas. He won the highest national Prize of Israel in Philosophy, 2000
