<Alt> Tab <Alt> <Shift> Tab	change window or application
<Primary> <Alt> Right	change to workspace on the right
<Primary> <Alt> Left	change to workspace on the left
<Primary> <Alt> KP-1	move application to workspace 1
<Primary> <Alt> KP-2	move application to workspace 2
<Primary> <Alt>l	lock screen
<Primary> <Alt>d	show desktop
<Primary> <Alt> <Delete>	shut downdd
<Primary> <Alt>F4 or <Primary> <Alt>F5 or <Primary> <Alt>F6	opens terminal independently of MATE GUI
<Primary> <Alt>F7	returns to MATE GUI
Print	Screenshooter, immediately take a picture of your screen
<Shift> Print	Open the screenshooter app and chose settings
