Prof. Mark Aldenderfer is an archaeologist who is recognised internationally for his pioneering research into human-environmental interrelations in high-altitude environments. He has worked on all three of the world's high plateaus (the Andean altiplano, the Ethiopian- and the Tibetan Plateau) and currently heads two multidisciplinary research projects focussed on the High Himalayas of Upper Mustang, Nepal and on far Western Tibet, respectively. In this seminar talk he will provide insights into the current state-of-the-art in geoarchaeological research on the Tibetan Plateau and the adjacent mountain ranges.
