Craig W. Kallendorf, professor at Texas A&M University, made his PhD in Comparative Literature with emphasis in Renaissance, classics, and rhetoric at the University of North Carolina. The title of his PhD was 'Early Humanistic Moral Criticism of Virgil's *Aeneid* in Italy and Great Britain'. A long series of articles and books on the reception of Virgil in Neo-Latin literature followed. As one of the most prolific US researchers in Neo-Latin literature, Kallendorf is visiting Austria this summer in his position as president of the *International Association for Neo-Latin Studies* (IANLS), whose triannual conference will take place in Vienna from 2nd-8th August 2015.
